# HARRISTON IS LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF MINTO IN WELLINGTON COUNTY.

Located in the northwestern boundary of Wellington County, the Town of Minto is well-situated between the major centres of southern Ontario and popular recreational areas along the eastern shore of Lake Huron and southern Georgian Bay.

Minto is located just 1 to 1-½ hours from cities in the "Golden Horseshoe" industrial heartland, like Toronto and Hamilton, and less than an hour from Kitchener-Waterloo, and Guelph.

The City of Owen Sound offers Great Lakes port shipping facilities, as does the Town of Goderich situated approximately 100 kilometres to the southwest.

Harriston is in the heart of Minto, located in the middle of the municipality, halfway between Clifford and Palmerston.

A grass roots, community revitalization has been underway in recent years, bringing together businesses, residents, service clubs, and local talent. Harriston has a little bit of everything – and something for everyone.

#### MARKET POSITION STATEMENT

Harriston's downtown is located at the intersection of two major highways providing access to thousands of customers every day.

With a strong service and convenience cluster the downtown is able to meet the needs of local residents and tourists. Downtown Harriston is centred on the Maitland River and is home to a wealth of cultural assets including the Heritage Town Hall Theatre and Carnegie Library, which houses an art gallery and heritage gallery, The Crown Cultural Centre, and the Old Post Centre for Business & Creativity.

These venues offer residents and visitors access to a variety of arts and culture experiences.



#### TANNERY PARK

Nestled in Harriston's downtown, Tannery Park lies directly over the Maitland River and is a quiet spot to sit and take in the bustle of this active community.

A hub for many community initiatives, Tannery Park features historic murals, flower beds, pergolas, outdoor furniture, and seasonal displays.



#### HARRISTON IS SELFIE CENTRAL

Murals, public art and seasonal selfie spots are ripe for the picking in downtown Harriston!

Brightly coloured backdrops and murals are placed throughout the community inviting residents, tourists and passersby to stop and strike their best pose.





#### COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAMS FOR COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS

The Town of Minto encourages and supports redevelopment of vacant, underutilized and/or contaminated properties and buildings known as "brownfields" within the entire boundary of the Town.

#### Grants available include:

- Structural Grants matching up to \$40,000
- Façade Improvement Grants matching up to \$3,000
- Outdoor Patio Grants matching up to \$3,000
- Signage Improvement Grants matching up to \$1,000
- Storefront Accessory Grant matching up to \$500
